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FTS MINISTRIES EVANGELISM, TRAINING AND MISSIONS ANNUAL REPORT FROM OCTOBER 2022 TO SEPTEMBER 2023 - SUMMARIZED

1. NARRATIVE SUMMARY: CHILD-FOCUSED/RELATED:

- a) **10,629 children** participated in spiritual nurturing activities through 148 children's clubs and Sunday schools in Nkhoma, Chilenje, Nkhotakota & Salima
- b) **3,003 children** were reached with the gospel of Jesus Christ in Nkhoma, Chilenje, Chigodi, Nkhotakota, Kasungu, & Mchinji through Jesus film shows and community-based outreaches
- c) **Number of Children who accepted Christ as Lord and Saviour:**
 - i. **2,250 children** during the outreaches
 - ii. **1,987 children** through the use Audibibles & Look, Listen and Live picture books from Nkhoma, Chilenje, Nkhotakota & Salima
- d) **2,203 comprising of children and adults** were exposed to the orientation training on gender-based violence & have been sensitized on their rights and the responsibilities that come with exercising them in the area of Senior Group Village Headman Mtambwa.
- e) **667 rabbits were purchased and distributed to 514 children** during Dare to Discover & Empowered View for children in Nkhoma, Chilenje & Chigodi on the basis of passing on to their peers during the breeding period.
 - i. **107 children received rabbits** from their peers as pass-on
Therefore, there are now 514 plus 107 = **621 children having rabbits** to rear with.

- f) **615 people (574 children & 41 adults)** participated in the Children's camp focusing on spiritual nurture of children in Nkhoma & Chilenje.
- g) **507 children** were enrolled into 12 Community-based child-care centres (CBCC) attached to churches and communities within Kalimanjira area in Nkhotakota (10) and Dwangwa Church Network in Kasungu (2)
- h) **TRAINING:**
 - i.** **456 children** were engaged and trained in Empowered World View for children (201) & Dare to Discover (255) in Nkhoma, Chilenje and Chigodi
 - ii.** **300 youth and adolescents** commenced in a four-year Impact + Project Model training in Nkhoma, Chilenje and Chigodi Area Programs.
 - iii.** **177 volunteer workers** were trained in Children's ministry training phase 1 (113) & 2 (64)
 - iv.** **24 youth** have been trained as facilitators for Impact + in Nkhoma, Chilenje and Chigodi
 - v.** **49 people** were trained in Children's Ministry training as volunteer teachers in Nkhotakota, Nkhoma & Chilenje
- i) **313 children participated in Children's Bible quiz** (134 from Nkhoma & Chilenje and 179 from within Nkhotakota)
- j) **258 children Bibles** were procured and distributed to Children's clubs
- k) **167 children** enrolled at Chisema Baptist School in Nkhotakota into reception one, reception two, standard one, standard two, standard three, standard 4 and standard 5
- l) **74 Audibibles** are actively used in Nkhoma, Chilenje and Nkhotakota
- h) **42 children and 20 adults participated** in the Lilongwe East Community Children's Parliament from Nkhoma, Chilenje & Chigodi. It took place at Ebenezer Primary school at Nkhoma mission.

2. NARRATIVE SUMMARY: ADULT-FOCUSED/RELATED:

- a) **2,461 adults** were reached with the gospel of Jesus Christ through adult-focused outreaches organized and conducted in Nkhoma, Chilenje, Chigodi, Nkhotakota, Kasungu & Mchinji through Jesus film shows and community outreaches.
 -  **1557 adults accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour** during these outreaches
- b) **979 adults** attended Bible study programs in Nkhoma, & Chilenje (560 in 47 clubs) and Nkhotakota (419 in 34 clubs)
 -  77 Audibibles and Look, Listen and Live picture books were used and 302 accepted Christ as Lord and Saviour.
- c) **714 goats of goat pass-on program are in 458 households:**
 - i. 614 goats in 392 households in Nkhoma and Chilenje and
 - ii. 100 goats in 66 households in Nkhotakota
- d) **521 adults** from 29 centres were engaged in Adult literacy lessons in Nkhotakota.
- e) **506 adults** from 23 Adult Bible study groups are being engaged in Farming God's Way (with emphasis on Vegetable gardening) in order to be equipped and break the yoke of poverty.
 - i. **K517,000.00 was made from vegetable sales in June**
 - ii. **K528,000.00 was made from vegetable sales in July**
 - iii. **K685,000.00 was made from vegetable sales in August.**
A total amount of K1,730,000.00 was made in total over the 3 months.
This is improving members' household's food security & income.
- f) **264 people (children & adults) were visited in Nkhotakota** during monitoring and evaluation in order to assess the impact and progress on Early Childhood Development Centres, Children's Bible Clubs, & Farming God's Way
- g) **254 Bibles** have been sold at subsidized price in the zones.
- h) **43 FTS staff & volunteers** participated in daily morning devotions and quarterly prayer programs in Nkhoma, Chilenje, Nkhotakota and at Mukani

i) **TRAINING PROGRAMMES:**

- i. **35 people (from 6 churches)** were trained in the Discipleship module of Tembenuka in Nkhotakota.
- ii. **34 people were trained** in Discipleship module 1 (Tembenuka) module 2 (Ubale) and module 3 (Mukani) in Dedza
- iii. **24 Faith leaders (12 couples)** were trained in Child Protection from Nkhoma and Chilenje
- iv. **20 faith leaders** were trained to be trainers of trainers in spiritual nurturing of a child.
- v. **15 people from Nkhoma and Chilenje went on a learning visit** on child protection best practices to Kasangadzi community within Dowa.
- vi. **9 church members from 3 churches were** trained in Evangelism module within Nkhoma area from Senior Group Village Headman Mtambwa.
